Oregon Entry Guidelines

1. Please print or type clearly on the entry form, as it will be on display with your quilt.
2. All applications must be complete, one application per entry. There is no charge to show your quilt. **Entry deadline is Thursday the day before the show at Old School Furniture.**
3. You may register as many quilts/garments as you want.
4. It is preferred that each quilt have a cloth label on the bottom back of the quilt with your name, address, and telephone number, and email address. Each garment must have a cloth label attached inside with the same information.
5. It is suggested that each quilt have a generous 4” sleeve sewn to the top edge of the quilt. (This may be a temporary sleeve, especially for antique quilts. This will give you the option to hang the quilt on the wall, rather than laying it on a recliner, couch, or table.
6. If you wish to sell your quilt/garment, please indicate on the entry form. All items sold will be charged a 10% commission payable to the Rhododendron Quilt Guild. It is expected that you will receive a check within 15 days of the end of the show if your quilted item is sold.
7. Insurance coverage for all entries is the responsibility of the entrants. Every effort will be made to monitor the security of all entries.
8. Check-in for all entries will be between **1:00pm and 4:00 pm Thursday, .** The check in area will be at the front entrance of the Old School Furniture, 6th and highway 101. Bring each item in a clear or white plastic, close-able, bag. You will be given a receipt for each entry. You will then be given the location of where your item(s) will be exhibited. You may be the one displaying your quilt, so you might want to bring someone with you to help set it up. Most items will be placed on couches, beds, recliners, or tables.
9. Pick up will be between 4:00 and 5:00 pm Saturday after the show closes at the entrance to the Old School Furniture. Receipts issued at check-in must be presented when you pick up your entries.
10. You are asked to send a short biography and a picture of yourself, preferably holding a quilt, which will be uniformly formatted and printed and placed at the entry way. Send it to Carri DeBolt at Abuelita360@aol.com.
